## Wildwood Boardwalk Reconstruction – Phase I *City of Wildwood, New Jersey*

*Atlantic City, NJ* – The New Jersey Society of Municipal Engineers (NJSME) has selected Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers as the Honor Place recipient in the Municipal Construction Projects – Populations under 20,000 “B” category. Marc DeBlasio, Regional Manager, received the award on behalf of the firm and the City of Wildwood on November 18, 2009 at the Annual League of Municipalities Conference in Atlantic City. Last year, Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers was awarded First Place in the same category for the Washington Street Mall Project for the City of Cape May, NJ.

Remington, Vernick & Walberg was retained to develop a comprehensive plan to reconstruct the Wildwood Boardwalk and all the utilities under it for its entire length. From this plan, construction documents were developed for one block from Cedar Avenue to Schellenger Avenue. The plans called for the complete demolition and reconstruction of the boardwalk. Included in the project was the replacement of water, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer utilities. Also a tunnel was designed so emergency vehicles can drive under the boardwalk to access the beach. The Wildwood Boardwalk is famous for its three mile long path of amusements and beach to entertain shore-crazy vacationers and tourists. It is home to the world famous “Tram Car”, shuttling visitors from one end of the boardwalk to the other, stopping at points of interest like amusements, restaurants, shops and game stands along the boardwalk.

The firm was responsible for the engineering, design, specification preparation, contract administration and construction inspection of this project. The project was completed on-time and within budget...just in-time for the official start of summer: Memorial Day.
