The Borough of West Cape May is proud to present this Letter of Recommendation on behalf of Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers (RVW) for your U.S.D.A. Rural Development Central Avenue Sanitary Sewer Replacement project.

Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers played the lead role for the Borough in the securing of a U.S.D.A. grant/loan in the amount of approximately \$3,500,000. The U.S.D.A. project included several phases of sanitary sewer, water main and roadway reconstruction. The funds requested met all the Borough's needs for this project. Upon completion of the original scope of work, the Borough had additional grant funds available. RVW, working in conjunction with my office, were successful in expanding the scope of work to include our new remote water meter reading system and the purchase of an emergency generator and trailer for our existing pump stations.
